Minutes of Meeting**1. Introduction**

- UNORC welcomed participants of shelter meeting. French Red Cross and SABSAS attended the meeting as representatives of watsan working group.

2. BRR Update

- No update from BRR

3. Update from UNORC

- UNORC informed that minutes of BAPPEDA meeting with NGOs on May 3 has been sent out to shelter organizations thus the latter are encouraged to send out update matrix of activities and identify issues that require further follow ups by Government of Aceh Barat and/ or BRR.

4. Issues of concern from NGOs***Shelter construction:***

- IOM plans to build permanent shelter in Meurebo, Kaway XVI, Arongan. It builds type 42 houses (36+). IOM informed that BRR encouraged IOM to build houses in those locations.
- To this, UNORC asked IOM and HABITAT to discuss bilaterally on issues regarding with location and beneficiaries of IOM in Keub,

Arongan Lambalek Sub district. UNORC also asked IOM to inform CRS on their plan to build houses in Suak Gedeubang, Samatiga.

- Spanish Red Cross (SRC) plans to install watsan facilities for its temporary shelter / permanent in Samatiga and Meureubo (Pasi Mesjid). SRC asked on whether organizations are in possession of geological study of soil and water in Suak Pante Breuh/ Samatiga as a reference to the watsan activity plan.
- CARITAS informed that after the BAPPEDA meeting with NGO s on May 3 2006 that it is no longer expect the government of Aceh Barat will provide land relocation for people from Padang Seurahet and Suak Indrapuri.
- UNORC informed that Bupati of Aceh Barat and head of departments, together with CARITAS will have a field inspection on Wednesday to Suak Indrapuri.

Road issue:

- French Red Cross informed that road to Arongan is damaged and has constrained the starting of health assesment activity.
- CRS proposed to use alternative route via Woyla but it takes 2 hours to get Arongan Lambalek.
- UNORC will gather information on the plan of Government of Aceh Barat on road rehabilitation in Arongan Lambalek.
- JRCS asked on the update information on the extension of JICS road project.

5. Temporary Shelter Activity Update

- SRC informed it waits for 200 units of timber. Has installed 200 IFRC TS in Suak Pante Breuh and will add 24 units. The rest of timber will be delivered to Lapang 2 and Marek site.
- CRS informed it will distributed 80 (or 102) its own designed TS. CRS has discussed with IFRC the possibility to install 49 units of IFRC TS in Arongan CRS will look forward to install 400 to 600 units in Tapaktuan, South Aceh.

6. AOB

- ***SABSAS plans to provide assistance in rehabilitating pipelines for water supply in July therefore asked agencies to send out information on the numbers of houses have been built and its location. The current priority areas is in Meurebo***
